CITY COUNCIL MEETING

March 20, 2017

The Regular Session of the Glenpool City Council was held at Glenpool City Hall, 3rd Floor, 12205 S. Yukon Ave, Glenpool, Oklahoma. Councilors present: Brandon Kearns, Councilor; Momodou Ceesay, Vice Mayor and Timothy Fox, Mayor. Councilor Jacqueline Triplett-Lund arrived at 6:06 p.m. Patricia Agee, Councilor was absent.

Staff present: Roger Kolman, City Manager; Lowell Peterson, City Attorney; Susan White, City Clerk; Julie Casteen, Finance Director; Lynn Burrow, Community Development Director; Rick Malone, City Planner; and Dennis Waller, Police Chief.

Also present were Rhoda Thompson from 2016 Leadership Glenpool; Sydney Bland, Exec. Dir., Glenpool Chamber of Commerce; and Rex Robertson, Ford Development Corporation.

- A) Mayor Fox called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.**
- B) Susan White, City Clerk called the roll. Mayor Fox declared a quorum present.**
- C) Rick Malone offered the Invocation.**
- D) Mayor Fox led the Pledge of Allegiance.**
- E) Community Development Report – Lynn Burrow, Community Development Director**
 - Mr. Burrow offered an update on the progress of numerous public and private construction projects throughout the city, including the AMR meter replacement project; South County Soccer Complex; South Elwood Mini Storage; St. Francis Health Center project; Hotel at Phillips Corner Addition; and Sidewalk project funded by ODOT grant. He further reported on various applications received by the Planning Department and slated for review, as well as information concerning activities in the Building/Inspections, and Code Enforcement Departments.

 - Mrs. Casteen presented a comprehensive report for January 2017 revenues and expenditures in all Funds.
- G) City Manager Report – Roger Kolman, City Manager**
 - Mr. Kolman reminded the Council and audience of the upcoming Public Forum slated for March 21 at 6:30 pm. Topics to be discussed are AMR system installation; curbside recycling; and stormwater management.
 - Mr. Kolman and Councilor Lund will travel to the state capitol on March 21 to participate in Municipal Government Day.
 - Pets in the Park 1st Annual Fundraiser will be held Saturday, March 25 from 2-4 p.m. at Black Gold Park. Donations will benefit the Glenpool Animal Shelter.

 - Mayor Fox, Vice Mayor Ceesay and Councilor Lund attended the recent FOP Banquet. Mayor Fox expressed his appreciation to Chief Waller for the invitation and exclaimed, “I was thoroughly impressed.”

Ms. Bland introduced Rhoda Thompson with the 2016 Leadership Class to present the sign design options, as well as other information specific to the recommended signs. Sample designs were displayed and Council was requested to select from three options. Signs will be installed above the current signage identifying 141st Street. The official street name will not change.

BACKGROUND:

We have received a request from Steve Boettcher with INCOG asking the City of Glenpool to declare April 2017 as "Fair Housing Month". The funds for the Community Development Block Grant program come from Tulsa County CDBG Urban County through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Over the years, the City of Glenpool has been the recipient of several CDBG grants from this program namely, the Senior Citizen Building Renovations, the Gazebo's In Black Gold Park, and the Streetscape for 141st Street.

In addition, the City of Glenpool is also a member of the Metropolitan Tulsa HOME Consortium, another source of HUD funding. One of the policies regarding these funds is that the grant recipients must implement an action to further fair housing for each year of funding they receive.

The funds for the Community Development Block Grant program which have been granted to the City of Glenpool come from the Tulsa County CDBG Urban County through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. In addition, the City of Glenpool is a member of the Metropolitan Tulsa HOME Consortium, another source of HUD funding.

One of the policies regarding these funds is that the grant recipients must implement an action to further fair housing for each year of funding they receive. One of the simplest ways to accomplish this is to declare April as *Fair Housing Month* in the recipient's jurisdiction. Cities and Towns may accomplish this by adopting a resolution. This action will meet the program requirements for the current year's funding.

RESOLUTION 17000

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING APRIL 2017 AS
FAIR HOUSING MONTH

WHEREAS, in April of 1968 one of the Nation's most important pieces of civil rights legislation- Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968- was adopted by the U.S. Congress; and

WHEREAS, Title VIII prohibits a wide range of discriminatory housing practices; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 strengthens the mandate to each community to affirmatively further fair housing; and

WHEREAS, communities receiving Community Development Block Grant funds and HOME funds are uniquely situated to positively impact housing opportunities; and

WHEREAS, in affirmatively furthering fair housing, CDBG and HOME communities are required to actively promote wider housing opportunities for all racial and ethnic groups while maintaining a nondiscriminatory environment in all aspects of the public and private housing market within their jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Glenpool wholeheartedly proclaims April 2017 as Fair Housing Month in Glenpool, Oklahoma.

BACKGROUND

This item is for Council consideration and action regarding the acceptance of a twenty foot (20') wide General Utility Easement dedication covering a certain tract of land located along, contiguous with, and parallel to the south right-of-way line of what will be 166th Street as illustrated on the attached documents. - 2) Grantee shall not be responsible for damage to permitted improvements placed within the general utility easement by the Grantor or third party resulting from repair, maintenance, or the installation of Grantee facilities;
- 3) Grantee has the right to recover the costs of any repairs necessary, due to the actions of the Grantor or other persons in privity with it, to the facilities the Grantee has installed within the general utility easement;
- 4) Changes in finished grade in excess of twelve (12) inches shall be prohibited;





South 75 Business Park Phase II General Utility Easement Exhibit






Ref: EMS Report March 1, 2017 – March 21, 2017

During the time of March 1st through March 21, 2017 we logged 70 calls for service with 100% response time compliance. Fifty patients were transported, ten were treated but refused transport, four required mutual aid, three calls were cancelled, and one DOA. We also utilized a second Mercy truck for four of the calls.

We have received two new memberships since March 1, 2017.

Mercy Regional was approved for a new sepsis protocol by the State. At the time, we were approved we were one of only three agencies within the State of Oklahoma to have an approved sepsis protocol. Treating sepsis in the field by EMS professionals is new to the Country and new for the State of Oklahoma but we will be able to save more lives by recognizing and treating Sepsis in the field. We continue to strive to provide the very best to our patients.

Mercy continues to talk with Chief Newton on the best communication solution with the new radios the fire department will be integrating within the next month or two. We plan on investing in equipment that will allow Mercy Regional Medics to communicate with the Glenpool Fire Department. This will be a significant financial investment for Mercy but it is imperative that all the first responders in Glenpool can communicate.
